HMMS Online Learning Expectations for Students:

- Our physical and virtual classroom expectations are the same so students are expected to follow the 3 Rs of Harry Miller Middle School: Respect, Responsibility, and Right Choices.
 - Respect
 - Be Kind to all learners
 - Consider your audience in Group chats – make sure you are on topic and appropriate with your comments
 - Mute your microphone – cuts down on background noise. Unmute to speak and then mute again.
 - Appropriate clothing is a must!
 - Responsibility
 - Think before you type – I am your teacher and we are learning.
 - Use appropriate grammar – Full sentences, no slang, remember “you are at school”
 - No memes – this is your learning space and not a “friend space”
 - Right Choices
 - Keep Personal Information Private (no tour of homes/ no pets/ no siblings/ no bedrooms- do this on your own time); use Teams backgrounds when you log in to keep areas of your home learning space private;
 - Be seated so you can really listen and engage in the learning/conversation
 - Privately Report to the teacher if someone has posted something or said something that makes you feel uncomfortable. You can do this through email and your teacher can call you.
